COVID-X Open Call #1

COVID-X has launched the Open Call #1 for Tech Companies with outstanding Data Technology solutions that can overcome COVID-19 clinical challenges. This Open Call is also addressed for healthcare providers dealing with coronavirus patients and validating the solutions in real care environments. The project will grant 100K€ in direct funding to validate data solutions in one of COVID-X clinical partners from Italy, Spain or Sweden (for Single Players). Tech Companies & Healthcare providers, working together to validate the solution, can apply up to 150K€ (for Team players). All solutions should address specific or open challenges related to diagnosis, prognosis or follow-up of COVID-19 patients.

CHIST-ERA Open Call 2020 Pre-Announce

The Call 2020 Pre-announcement is online and available. The CHIST-ERA Call 2020, to be published in December 2020 or beginning of January 2021, will target research in the following topics:

- Advanced Brain-Computer Interfaces for Novel Interactions (BCI)
- Towards Sustainable ICT (S-ICT)
 To help researchers finding partners,
- a <u>Partner Search Tool</u> is provided in order to submit expressions of interest by filling-in a web form.

17 Israeli Researchers Won the Prestige 2020 ERC-CoG Grant

17 of the 327 European Research Council Consolidator Grants (ERC-CoG) will be awarded to researchers from Israel, with a total funding of approximately € 34.5 million (out of a total of €655 million). This represent about 5% of the total awards and the call budget.

Among the 17 laureates, three mathematicians, three in the fields of Systems and Communication Engineering and two from the Humanities.

Israeli Winners in the Last Round of the EIC Accelerator

Four Israeli companies were selected for funding in the last round of the EIC Accelerator program:

HIL Applied Medical, Omnix Medical, Respinova, and Yoran Imaging. Israel came in second place in the number of winning companies (along with France).

The selected Israeli companies won grants of € 44 million and Equity of € 62 million.

ECOncrete Tech LTD, Won FTI Funding

ECOncrete Tech LTD, was selected for funding in the last round of the prestigious FTI program. ECOncrete Tech LTD will lead as a consortia coordinator with partners from Spain and Denmark. The selected project will deal with the industrialization of ECOncrete's revolutionary technology and will serve as a first and decisive step towards a fundamental change in the system, currently the CMI industry is moving from non-ecological building materials and old "gray" designs to technologies that cultivate ecological, socio-economic and science-based values.

Commission's Sustainable and Smart Mobility Strategy

The strategy outlines how the EU transport system can achieve a green and digital transformation and become more resilient to future crises. As outlined in the European Green Deal, the result will be a 90% cut in emissions by 2050, delivered by a smart, competitive, safe, accessible and affordable transport system. The document indicates that the Commission is investing heavily in research and pre-deployment testing through funding instruments such as Horizon Europe, and the Connecting Europe Facility.

EOSC Portal Unveils New and Improved Major Release

The new release features the new EOSC model for the description of <u>providers</u> and <u>resources</u>, more automated processes especially in onboarding resources to the portal, allows providers more control over their resources, enriches the information for each resource allowing users to make better choices, and supports users with more information such as <u>tutorial</u> and <u>documentation</u> areas for providers.

Across the portal, feedback mechanisms have also been implemented to allow users and providers to provide feedback to the enhancements implemented in the portal.
