Starting from the areas of major cooperation between Israel and Italy, the event – entitled **Israel And Italy Cooperation In Horizon Framework Programme** – intends to further enhance IL-IT cooperation in Research and Innovation through the exchange of good practices and the identification of new paths for cooperation, especially under the current European Programme for Research and Innovation “Horizon Europe”.

A **Panel Discussion** will be held among **3 projects of successful cooperation**, selected under the main areas of collaboration between Israel and Italy under H2020 (Agrifood, Health, ICT). As concrete opportunities for synergies and collaboration among Israeli/Italian researchers and innovators, these projects will present their main outcomes or expected results, to be further exploited to create new partnerships and ideas for cooperation.

ISERD will present its analysis of joint-collaborations under H2020, while APRE will offer an overview of the opportunities for IL-IT cooperation under Horizon Europe, with a special focus on the *Destinations* of the Programme that are particularly relevant in the framework of the EU Global Approach to Research and Innovation.
